LimsNet Submissions

- What is LimsNet?
 - ISDH Lab's electronic specimen submission system that allows submitters to submit lab testing requests electronically rather than with paper form and view results instantly.
- Benefits
 - No need to fill out submission forms in triplicate—can use patient lookup feature in LimsNet
 - Reduced turnaround time—results are available sooner—no need to rely on faxing or mailing
 - Delays in testing due to incomplete patient/submitter information are virtually eliminated
 - Submitters are able to view, print and save laboratory reports as PDF files at their convenience.
 - Currently, 98% of specimens submitted to ISDH labs are via LimsNet—goal is 100%


LimsNet Patient Information Screen

1. Login into LimsNet with username and password
2. Select the type of test from Log New Test.
3. Below are the list of tests that can be submitted in LimsNet

- CTGC
- HIV/Hep
- Syphilis
- Tuberculosis
- BloodLead
- Virology
- Rabies
- Outbreak Serology

4. User can submit only tests they are authorized to submit.
5. Type in the patient's Clinic ID number.
6. Click "Lookup Info" to populate patient demographics for existing patients. For new patients fill in patient information.
7. Be sure to complete the required fields marked in red.
8. Click "Save".
9. Repeat for additional specimens.

Submit Tests Screen

1. Click “Submit Tests”.
2. Click on Edit if you need to edit some data.
3. Delete will delete the sample information from the system.
4. Check the box next to the specimens you intend to ship.
5. Multiple samples of same Test Types can be packaged and sent together
6. Enter the UPS Tracking Number if available
7. Click on “Mark as Shipped”.
8. Print LimsNet cover sheet and ship it with specimens.

Unsatisfactory specimens

- Most common causes of sample rejection :
 - No specimen in the collection tube
 - No name on the collection tube
 - Name on collection tube is illegible
 - Name on collection tube and form do not match
 - Leaking collection tube
